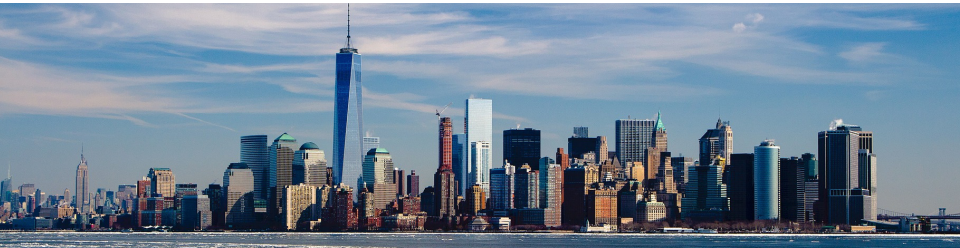

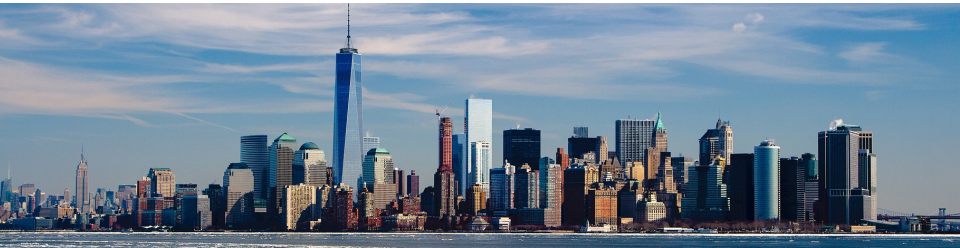
This free symposium is designed for clinical providers such as **physicians, physician assistants, nurses and nurse practitioners** who provide direct care to adolescent patients.
